

3 WAYS TO VOTE IN SACRAMENTO COUNTY

#1 Vote by Mail:



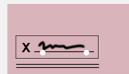
Ballots are sent out starting 29 days before the Election Day.



Once you have received your ballot in the mail:



Vote your ballot



Seal and sign the envelope
(no postage necessary)

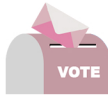


And return your
ballot by mail!



It can only be accepted if it is postmarked on or before Election Day and received by our office within seven (7) days after Election Day. The sooner your ballot is returned, the sooner it is processed.

#2 Ballot Drop Box:



All Ballot Drop Box locations open 29 days before Election Day and are open during the location's regular business hours.

#3 In Person at a Vote Center:

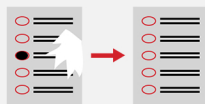


At any of our Vote Center locations located in Sacramento County, voters can:

✓ Vote your ballot



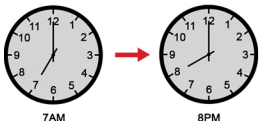
✓ Request a replacement
