June Primary Voting Begins Monday

Vote By Mail ballots in the mail

Registrar of Voters, Jill LaVine announced that beginning Monday, May 5, 2014 ballots for the June 3 Primary Election will be available at the Election Office. Vote By Mail ballots will be in the mail next week to all Permanent Vote By Mail voters and to any voter who has already requested a ballot for this election.

It's not too late to vote by mail for the June 3, 2014 election. Registered voters have until May 27, 2014 to request a vote by mail ballot be mailed to them. You can request a vote by mail ballot by using the application printed on the back of the sample ballot booklet, obtain an application online at www.elections.sacounty.net, or call the Elections Office at (916) 875-6155.

Key Election Dates

May 19 – Last day to register to vote in the June 3 Statewide Direct Primary Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. You can also register on-line at registertovote.ca.gov.

May 27 – Last day to request a vote by mail ballot be mailed to you for the June 3, 2014 election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

June 3 – Statewide Direct Primary Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
