- Have at least a 2.5 GPA?
- Are you able to read and write English?
- Are you able to attend a 2½ hour mandatory training class?
- Are you available to work from 6:00am to 10:00pm on Election day?
- Are you reachable by phone?
- Do you have a ride to and from your assigned polling place on Election Day?

You get paid!

You will get \$25.00 for attending the mandatory training class and \$120.00 for working on Election Day.

It takes approximately 4 to 6 weeks after Election Day for us to process your check.

What would you be doing?

- Set up the voting equipment and polling place before the polls open at 7:00am
- Assist voters
- Issue and receive official ballots
- Break down the voting equipment and complete all closing procedures once the polls close at 8:00pm
