**Registrar of Voters Election Update**  
**Sacramento County Offers Vote-by-Mail**  
**Drop-off Sites for the June 8 Primary Election**

Voters have another option to get their Vote-by-Mail ballots to the Elections Office in time to be counted for the June 8 Primary Election. Beginning Tuesday, June 1 through Friday, June 4, Sacramento County's downtown administration center and designated city clerk offices throughout the County will serve as Vote-by-Mail ballot drop-off sites.

Ballot collection boxes will be stationed at the Clerk of the Board office located on the 2nd floor of the County Administration building and at the front counters of participating city clerk offices. "We understand that it may be more convenient for some voters to drop off their ballot rather than sending it through the mail," says Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine. "We have partnered with our Clerk of the Board and local city clerks to provide additional drop-off locations within the community that may be closer to voters' home or work."

Voters may also deposit their ballots 24 hours a day, and until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, at the Elections Office located at 7000 65th Street, Sacramento California.
