### **Last Day to Register for November Consolidated General Election**

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that those interested in voting in the upcoming Statewide General Election have until Monday, October 18, 2010 to register to vote.

“We urge everyone who is not currently registered to participate in this election by making sure they are registered,” says LaVine.

Voter Registration cards are available at libraries, post offices and government buildings.

#### **Key dates for voters**

- October 18, 2010 - Last day to register to vote in General Election.
- October 26, 2010 - Last day to request a VBM (Absentee) ballot be mailed to you. (A VBM request form can be found on the back cover of the Sample Ballot Booklet. These requests must be received by the Elections Office by 5:00 p.m.)
- November 2, 2010 – Election Day – Polls are open from 7:00a.m. until 8:00p.m.
