**VOTERS WHO RE-REGISTERED NEED TO
DOUBLE-CHECK THEIR POLLING LOCATIONS**

Sacramento County voters who registered between October 4 and October 18 will begin receiving cards in the mail this week that inform them of their new polling location. Some cards may contain old information based on the voter's prior address. Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine urges all voters to double check their polling location before they vote on Election Day.

"We discovered that due to a software problem, some voters who registered just before the October 18th deadline received polling place location cards with their previous polling place listed in error," said LaVine. "Of the 678,923 registered voters in the County, approximately 4000 voters were affected, and a correct polling location card will be mailed to them."
