ARE YOU READY TO VOTE ON ELECTION DAY?

Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine wants to give voters some last minute reminders and tips that can make your trip to the polls go a little smoother on Election Day.

- Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Mark your choices in your Sample Ballot Booklet ahead of time and take it with you into the voting booth
- If you make a mistake on your ballot, ask a Precinct Officer for a new ballot
- If you are in line when the polls close, you will be allowed to vote
- Can't make it to your polling place or your name is not on the list? Ask to vote by provisional ballot. The provisional ballot will be counted after the elections office has confirmed that you are registered to vote and you did not already vote elsewhere in the election
- Even vote-by-mail ballots must be turned in by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day - Postmarks **do not** count. Drop off your vote-by-mail ballot at any polling place in Sacramento County or at the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Sacramento
