Sacramento County Special General Election Update

Last Day to Register for the January 4 Special General Election

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminds anyone interested in voting in the upcoming Special General Election they have until Monday, December 20, 2010 to register. "We urge individuals who are not currently registered to do so before the deadline," says LaVine.

To find out if you are currently registered to vote or update your address information, go to the Elections website: www.elections.saccounty.net/VotingInformation.

The Governor called a special general election to be held January 4, 2011 to fill the vacancy in Senate District 1 (SD1) left by the passing of Senator Dave Cox. This election will encompass approximately one-third of the County. Refer to the [SD1](#) map on the Elections website for the district boundaries in Sacramento County.
