Tomorrow is Election Day!

January 4 Special General Election to fill Senate District 1 vacancy

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminds anyone voting in tomorrow's January 4 Special General Election to double check their polling place and return vote-by-mail ballots to a polling place or the Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. or it won't count.

The Governor called a special general election to fill the vacancy in Senate District 1 (SD1) left by the passing of Senator Dave Cox. This election encompasses approximately one-third of Sacramento County. See the [SD1](#) map on the Elections website for the district boundaries.

Election Day Tips

- Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
- Some polling places have changed for this election so be sure to check your sample ballot book for your voting location
- Locate your polling place by typing in your address on our [Polling Place Lookup](#) or call the automated polling place lookup at (916) 875-6500
- If you make a mistake on your ballot, ask a Precinct Officer for a new ballot
- If you are in line when the polls close, you will be allowed to vote
- Even vote-by-mail ballots must be turned in by 8:00 p.m. on Election Day - Postmarks **do not** count. Drop off your vote-by-mail ballot at any polling place in Sacramento County or at the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Sacramento
