The polls are open and voting is underway in the Senate District 1 (SD1) contest. This election encompasses approximately one-third of Sacramento County. View SD1 district boundaries on the Elections website at www.elections.saccounty.net.

Forgot to mail your vote-by-mail ballot? Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminds voters they must drop off their vote-by-mail ballot at any polling place or the Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. or it won't count.
