### **Sacramento County Special General Election Update**

### **Registrar Certifies Election, Releases Final Results**

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that the January 4 Special General Election for the Senate District 1 (SD1) race has been completed. Final results are posted online at [www.elections.saccounty.net](http://www.elections.saccounty.net).

With the completion of the SD1 contest, the Elections Office will now prepare for another special election to fill the Assembly District 4 (AD4) vacancy left by Assemblymember Gaines. AD4 covers Alpine and portions of Sacramento, Placer and El Dorado counties. Sacramento's portion of AD4 has approximately 40,000 voters. California law gives Governor Jerry Brown 14 days to call a special election after a legislative vacancy occurs.

#### **SD1 Special General Election Facts**

- 21.6% - SD1 election total turnout
- 83% - Ballots cast by vote-by-mail
- 17% - Voter turnout at polls
- 229,320 Sacramento County registered voters in SD1
