#### **Last Day to Register for Assembly District 4 Special Primary Election**

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that citizens residing in Assembly District 4 have until Tuesday, February 22 to register to vote.

"We urge everyone who is not currently registered, and who resides in Assembly District 4, to participate in this election by making sure they are registered," says LaVine.

#### **Key dates for voters in Assembly District 4**

- February 22, 2011 - Last day to register to vote in Special Primary Election.
- March 1, 2011 - Last day to request a VBM ballot be mailed to you. A VBM request form can be found on the back cover of your Sample Ballot Booklet. These requests must be received by the Elections Office by 5:00 p.m.
- March 8, 2011 – Election Day – Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
