Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Update

New Option for Voters to View Sample Ballot Booklets

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that Sacramento County voters can now choose to receive an electronic version of their sample ballot booklet online.

For many people, getting information online using a computer is convenient and time-saving. "Voters can view and download their sample ballot booklet when they need it no matter where they are," said LaVine

Beginning January 1, 2011, state law (AB1717) allows voters to 'go green' by choosing to opt out of receiving their sample ballot booklet by mail, and accessing it online instead.

"We are always looking for ways to conserve resources while increasing voter turnout, so it just made sense to offer voters a choice," stated LaVine.

To sign up for the opt-out option, visit the Sacramento County Elections website at www.elections.saccounty.net and complete the form online. Voters who try it and change their mind can resume the practice of getting it delivered in the mail.

If you choose to continue to receive the sample ballot booklet by mail, do nothing, and no changes will be made.
