Sacramento County Special General Election Update

Ballots Hand Talled in Two Precincts

Public and media invited to observe

On Monday, March 7, 2011, Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine will select the precincts to be included in the 1% manual tally for the upcoming Assembly District 4 Special Primary Election.

“For this election, it means all ballots cast at 2 of the County’s 15 precincts will be counted manually to ensure the accuracy of the automated count before certifying election results,” said LaVine. The manual tally is required by California law.

The randomly selected precincts represent 1% of the County’s polling places. Added to this 1% manual tally will be the manual tally of ballots from any precinct that experiences problems with its precinct scanner on Election Day. A list of these affected precincts, if any, will be available March 9.

The canvass will begin the day after the election on March 9, 2011.
