Sacramento County Special General Election Update

Elections Office Conducts Logic and Accuracy Testing for the May 3 Special General Election

Sacramento County Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that logic and accuracy testing on the voting machines for the May 3, 2011 Special Assembly District 4 (AD4) General Election will begin on April 4 and run continuously until completed. "Interested parties can observe our testing of each machine for accuracy in the tabulation of votes," said LaVine.

AD4 covers parts of the following counties - Sacramento, Placer, El Dorado and Alpine. Sacramento's portion of AD4 is approximately 40,000 voters.

Key dates for voters

- April 18 - Last day to register to vote in the Special General Election (registration form must be postmarked no later than this date).
- April 26 - Last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed to you. A VBM request form can be found on the back cover of the sample ballot booklet. These requests must be received by the Elections Office no later than 5:00 p.m.
- May 3, 2011 – Election Day – Polls are open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m.
