Redistricting Begins in Sacramento County

New website offers opportunities for citizen input and information on redistricting

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine announced today that a redistricting website is now available for Sacramento County residents to find dates of upcoming community workshops, view maps of existing districts, and comment on redistricting plans.

The website is www.elections.saccounty.net/Redistricting.

Every 10 years, after the U. S. census, Sacramento County must redraw Supervisorial district lines to ensure the five districts are as equal in population as possible. "Redistricting is done so that every resident is represented fairly within each supervisorial district," said LaVine.

The Voter Registration and Elections office will prepare five plans for review and comment by the public. Residents are encouraged to provide input on the draft plans. These plans will also be available for viewing on the Voter Registration and Elections website and at community workshops held throughout the County. The Board of Supervisors will adopt a final plan based on input from the public in August.
