Board of Supervisors Agree on Final Redistricting Plan

The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors unanimously agreed on a plan to change supervisorial district boundaries at today's public hearing. Redistricting is required after each US census to adjust the boundaries to make them as equal in population as possible.

During the previous redistricting hearing on August 24, Supervisors narrowed down the number of proposed plans being considered to nine and created an additional draft, ES1e (draft 4). At today's hearing, Supervisors made additional adjustments to draft plan ES1e (draft 4) that resulted in the final redistricting plan.

The most significant changes in the supervisorial districts are the shift of Fair Oaks from Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4) to Supervisor Peters (District 3); Rancho Murieta moved from Supervisor Nottoli (District 5) to Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4); Rio Linda and Elverta moved from Supervisor Serna (District 1) to Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4); and a section of Old Land Park moved from Supervisor Yee (District 2) to Supervisor Serna (District 1). On September 20, the Board of Supervisors will introduce an ordinance to legally change the district boundaries. The new boundaries will take effect 30 days following the adoption of the ordinance.
