### **New Board of Supervisors District Maps Take Effect November 3**

The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors' redrawn district boundaries will become official on Thursday, November 3, 2011. The new maps reflect population changes that have occurred during the past 10 years and will be used in the upcoming 2012 elections.

"The final part of Sacramento County's 2011 redistricting process is now complete," said Jill LaVine, Registrar of Voters. "Some residents may find they now live in a different district and are represented by another supervisor."

The new districts are largely the same as the previous districts, but with a few significant differences. Fair Oaks shifts from Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4) to Supervisor Peters (District 3); Rancho Murieta moved from Supervisor Nottoli (District 5) to Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4); Rio Linda and Elverta moved from Supervisor Serna (District 1) to Supervisor MacGlashan (District 4); and a section of Old Land Park moved from Supervisor Yee (District 2) to Supervisor Serna (District 1).
