Presidential Primary Election Update

Logic and Accuracy Testing for Voting Machines to Begin

Sacramento County Elections will begin Logic and Accuracy (L&A) testing for their voting machines in preparation for the upcoming June 5 Presidential Primary Election. Testing starts on April 23, 2012 and will run continuously until completed.

“Logic and Accuracy testing is the process by which voting equipment is configured, tested, and certified for accuracy prior to an election,” said Jill LaVine, Registrar of Voters. “Each component is tested to verify that it is fully functional and free from mechanical problems, and ensures that all votes cast are properly recorded on the system.”

Key Election Dates

May 21 – Last day to register to vote in the Presidential Primary Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823.

May 29 – Last day to request a vote-by-mail ballot be mailed to you for the June Presidential Primary Election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

June 5 – Statewide Presidential Primary Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
