Key Election Dates

APR 13 - First day a vote by mail ballot can be issued for Twin Rivers USD Area 5 Special Election.

APR 27 – Last day to register to vote in the May 12 Twin Rivers USD Area 5 Special Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823.

MAY 5 – Last day to request a vote by mail ballot be mailed to you for the May 12 Twin Rivers USD Area 5 Special Election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

MAY 12 – Twin Rivers USD Area 5 Special Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
