Statewide Direct Primary Election Update

May 19 Last Day to Register for June 3 Election

Registrar of Voters Jill LaVine reminds Sacramento County residents that the last day to register to vote is May 19, 2014. You can register online at registertovote.ca.gov or you can get a registration form at most libraries, post offices or the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823.

It is important that your voter registration form is filled out completely and postmarked or hand-delivered to the Elections Office at least 15 days before the election. Online forms need to be submitted before midnight on May 19 to be eligible for the June 3 Election.

Key Election Dates

May 19 – Last day to register to vote for the June 3 Statewide Direct Primary Election. Voter registration forms must be mailed (postmarked by this date) or delivered to the Elections Office, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento 95823. You can also register online at registertovote.ca.gov.

May 27 – Last day to request a vote by mail ballot be mailed to you for the June 3, 2014 election. Call (916) 875-6155 for information.

June 3 – Statewide Direct Primary Election. Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.
