## NEXT SCHEDULED ELECTIONS:

**Primary – June 5, 2018    General – November 6, 2018**

**NEW!** Sacramento County is preparing to implement the **Voter's Choice Act** (Senate Bill 450) to expand voting opportunities for the voters in our County. This Act replaces traditional Election Day-only polling places with Vote Centers where any voter in Sacramento County can vote at any designated location starting 10 days before Election Day. This Act would also increase the number of ballot drop-off locations starting 28 days before Election Day.

### VOTE CENTERS – Available starting 10 days before Election Day

#### 11 Day Commitment

May 26, 2018 – June 5, 2018

\*Includes Memorial Day, May 28

#### 11 Day Commitment

October 27, 2018 – November 6, 2018

#### 4 Day Commitment

June 2, 2018 – June 5, 2018

#### 4 Day Commitment

November 3, 2018 – November 6, 2018

#### Vote Center Requirements:

- Designated area or room for voting, ideally at least 30ft x 30ft, free of other activities
- Secured storage available for voting equipment
- Open to voters a minimum of 8 hours per day, Election Day open 7:00am - 8:00pm
- Facility access to Vote Center Staff one hour before and one hour after voting hours
- Restrooms available for Vote Center staff
- Parking available for voters and Vote Center staff
- Accessibility survey conducted by county elections officials

### VOTE BY MAIL DROP BOX – Available starting 28 days before Election Day

#### 29 Day Commitment

May 8, 2018 – June 5, 2018

#### 29 Day Commitment

October 9, 2018 – November 6, 2018

#### Drop Box Requirements:

- Secured location
- Available during your regular business hours but must be open on Election Day
- Accessibility survey conducted by county elections officials
