

NOTICE OF ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that the Retirement Board of the Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System (SCERS) will conduct a Member Election during the period of September 21 through October 2, 2009, for the purpose of electing:

ONE SAFETY MEMBER AND ONE ALTERNATE SAFETY MEMBER

The term of office beginning January 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2012.

ELECTED BOARD MEMBERS: Safety members of SCERS include employees whose principal duties consist of active law enforcement, or active fire suppression, or who occupy positions designated by law as safety positions. The elected Safety Member of the Board shall be the safety candidate from either active law enforcement or active fire suppression who receives the highest number of votes from safety members of SCERS. The elected Alternate Safety Member of the Board shall be the safety candidate who received the highest number of votes who is from the group (law enforcement or fire suppression) not elected as the Safety Member of the Board. For example, if the elected Safety Member is from law enforcement, then the candidate from fire suppression with the highest number of votes will be the elected Alternate Safety Member.

ELIGIBILITY: In order to be a candidate or to be eligible to vote in the Retirement Board Member Election, an employee must be an active safety member of the Sacramento County Employees' Retirement System according to System records. Only safety members may be candidates and/or vote for the Safety Retirement Board Member.

October 2, 2009 5 p.m.	Last day to cast ballot/Election Day
October 5, 2009	Official results released
January 1, 2010	Term of office begins

CANDIDACY INFORMATION: Nomination papers and candidate's statement forms may be obtained and filed at Voter Registration and Elections, 7000 65th Street, Suite A, Sacramento, CA 95823, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Candidates are requested to pick up and file their nomination papers in person. If a representative is delegated this responsibility, a specific letter of authorization signed by the candidate will be required.

Each candidate is allowed one 200-word statement of qualifications, which will be included in each member's voting material. This statement of qualifications is not verified or corrected by Voter Registration and Elections staff. It will be printed exactly as presented.
